

2024 Scholarship Application

Dear Student,

The VRGA Scholarship Committee reviews ONLY applications that are 100% complete and have all requested supporting materials attached. Your application will NOT be considered if any items are missing, areas on the application are left blank, or the application is submitted after April 26, 2024.

The following is a checklist of all the information required.

Please retain this as your guide. Before emailing your Scholarship application have you:
Completed ALL areas on the application.
Emailed a copy of your Student Aid Report (SAR) from FAFSA application (the page that shows the EFC amount—Estimated Family Contribution)
Emailed a copy of your financial aid letter from the college you plan to attend. Cost of tuition, room and board, books, and lab fees.
Entered your SAT/ACT Scores Emailed a copy of your high school transcripts Signed the application
Sent a photo (senior picture or headshot) with a photo release (at end of application)
Emailed a recommendation from your current employer. If not employed, two recommendations from other adults(i.e. mentor, coach, community service supervisor, etc.) are required.
Upload an outside recommendation (i.e. teacher, guidance counselor, coach, etc.)

IMPORTANT: You may only submit one school for consideration. If you change schools and have been awarded a scholarship, your application will be reviewed for eligibility.

IT IS THE STUDENT'S RESPONSIBILITY to follow up with the VRGA office prior to the April 21st deadline to confirm all necessary materials and application have been received. It is recommended all supporting materials and application be emailed or mailed together whenever possible to avoid missing items.

Vermont Retail & Grocers Association 2024 Scholarship Program

PURPOSE

To provide financial assistance to eligible students entering their first year at an accredited two or four-year school in the United States.

ELIGIBILITY

The applicant must:

- be a Vermont resident or be affiliated with a VRGA Member in Vermont;
- be a graduating high school senior planning to attend a US accredited two or four year postsecondary school or;
- plan to attend for the first time a US accredited two or four-year postsecondary school in 2024 and have received a high school diploma;
- file a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) no later than four weeks prior to the scholarship deadline listed below;

and meet one or more of the following conditions:

- be the dependent of an employee or owner of a VRGA member company. Company or Employee must be located in Vermont or have responsibility in Vermont;
- be an employee of a VRGA retail or associate member company in Vermont. Employee must be located in Vermont or have responsibility in Vermont.
- The employee must be employed a minimum of 15 hours per week or 750 hours per year;
 and have been employed at a VRGA retail member store or company for a minimum of one year at the time the student applies for this scholarship.

AMOUNT

Ten Scholarships will be awarded according to following criteria:

- (3) \$1,500 academic scholarships awarded based on merit.
- (7) \$1,500 scholarships awarded based on financial need and merit.

DEADLINE

APRIL 26, 2024 - Completed application & supporting documents must be **postmarked** by this date. Applications will not be considered if sections of the application are blank or supporting documents are missing.

PLEASE NOTE: Scholarships are made payable to both the student and the school. Some schools may adjust other financial aid based on scholarships received.
