# 3SquaresVT Good for Your Business!

## In 2019, 3SquaresVT gave Vermonters over \$100 million to spend in the state's grocery stores and markets.

Becoming an authorized 3SquaresVT retailer will increase your sales and provide an important service to your customers and your community. 3SquaresVT supports both the people who receive benefits and local retailers.

### Is my store eligible?

In order to participate as a 3SquaresVT retail store, your business must meet one of the two eligibility standards:

Sell at least three stocking units of three varieties of foods in each of the following four staple food groups on a daily basis (this includes perishable foods in at least two of the following categories):

- Meat, poultry, or fish
- Bread or cereal
- Vegetables or fruits
- Dairy products

#### OR:

Receive more than 50% of gross sales from the sale of these staple foods.\* \*Specialty stores, such as butcher shops, are often authorized this way.

### APPLY TO BECOME AN AUTHORIZED RETAILER

The fastest way to apply to accept 3SquaresVT/SNAP is by filling out an online application with the USDA Food and Nutrition Service at **www.fns.usda.gov/snap/retailers/application-process.htm.** You can also request a paper application be mailed to you by calling **1-877-823-4369**. The packet will be mailed to you within five days.

The authorization process usually takes about 30-45 days and involves an application form, training, and equipment set up. For questions about the application process, please visit **www.hungerfreevt.org/information-for-retailers.** 

The state's EBT contractor will contact you after your application is approved to discuss equipment options for your store to process 3SquaresVT sales. Please note that there is no longer free EBT equipment and service for most retailers.
