Vermont Retail & Grocers Association 2021 Scholarship Program

PURPOSE

To provide financial assistance to eligible students entering their first year at an accredited two or four-year school.

ELIGIBILITY

The applicant must:

- be a Vermont resident or be affiliated with a VRGA Member in Vermont;
- be a graduating high school senior planning to attend an accredited two or four year postsecondary school or;
- plan to attend for the first time an accredited two or four-year postsecondary school in 2021 and have received a high school diploma;
- file a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) no later than four weeks prior to the scholarship deadline listed below;

and meet one or more of the following conditions:

- be the dependent of an employee or owner of a VRGA member company. Company or Employee must be located in Vermont or have responsibility in Vermont;
- be an employee of a VRGA retail or associate member company in Vermont. Employee must be located in Vermont or have responsibility in Vermont.
- The employee must be employed a minimum of 15 hours per week or 750 hours per year; and have been employed at a VRGA retail member store or company for a minimum of one year at the time the student applies for this scholarship.

AMOUNT

Ten Scholarships will be awarded according to following criteria:

- (3) \$1,500 academic scholarships awarded based on merit.
- (7) \$1,500 scholarships awarded based on financial need and merit.

DEADLINE

APRIL 23, 2021 - Completed application & supporting documents must be **postmarked** by this date. Applications will not be considered if sections of the application are blank or supporting documents are missing.

PLEASE NOTE: Scholarships are made payable to both the student and the school. Some schools may adjust other financial aid based on scholarships received.

INSTRUCTIONS: Complete this application and mail or email to the Vermont Retail & Grocers Association, postmarked no later than **April 23, 2021**. You will receive notification from the VRGA Scholarship Committee in early June. **Please type or print in BLACK ink.**
